Analysis of selected Second Quarter 2009 Industry sector changes: April - June

***Construction**: There were overall losses of 300 jobs. Residential building construction lost 400 jobs.

***Manufacturing**: There were overall losses of 400 jobs. Computer & electronic products lost 400 jobs and residual miscellaneous manufacturing lost 700 jobs

***Health Services**: There were overall gains of 300 jobs. Ambulatory health services gained 200 jobs and nursing & residential care facilities gained 100 jobs.

***Retail Trade**: There were overall gains of 100 jobs. The largest gains were in clothing & clothing accessories stores and general merchandise with 200 jobs each.

***Leisure & Hospitality**: There were overall gains of 1,400 jobs. Arts, entertainment, & recreation gained 800 jobs, and food services & drinking places gained 600 jobs.

***Other Services**: There were overall gains of 500 jobs. Religious, grants, civic, professional & like organizations added the most with 300 jobs.

***Financial Activities**: There were overall gains of 200 jobs. Credit intermediation & related activities picked up 100 jobs and real estate picked up 200 jobs.
